The Educational Opportunity Centers Program (TRIO EOC) provides college admissions information, financial aid information, and financial literacy to qualified adults who want to start or continue their college studies.

### Who is Eligible?

Capital Region adults are eligible for the EOC Program if they meet the following requirements:

- At least 19 years old
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident status
- Income eligible, based on federal income guidelines or
- First-generation to college
- Desire to enroll, reenroll, or are enrolled in college (associate or bachelor's degree), and requests information or assistance in applying for admission to, or financial aid for, such a program

### What Services Do We Offer?

- Guidance on secondary school reentry to a General Educational Development (GED) program
- Financial and economic literacy
- College admission application assistance
- College entrance exams guidance
- Financial aid application assistance
- Individualized personal, career, academic counseling, and tutorial services
- Mentorship from faculty members, students, and others
- Academic advice and course selection assistance

TRIO EOC at the University at Albany is a federally funded five-year grant through the U.S. Department of Education with an annual budget of \$232,050 to support 850 eligible adults.
