The Commissioners of the Troy Housing Authority met in person and remotely via zoom, on Wednesday August 13, 2025 @ 4:30 PM at the Martin Luther King Apartments

Community Center. Chair Sanders, called the Meeting to Order and led the Assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon Roll Call, all seven Commissioners were present.

Chair Sanders called to move Resolution 25-13, the approval of the minutes of the regular meeting of the Troy Housing Authority held on June 25, 2025. Commissioner Rodriguez moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Mason second the motion. When put to a vote, the minutes were approved.

Chair Sanders moved to Resolution 25-14, a resolution authorizing the Executive

Director to execute a contract with Gallivan Corporation to perform full-service landscaping and grounds maintenance services at the Griswold Heights Apartment Complex for the remainder of the 2025 Season and the full year 2026 and 2027 seasons. Commissioner McAvoy moved to approve the resolution. Commissioner Howard seconded the motion. When put to a vote, the resolution passed unanimously.

Chair Sanders moved to Resolution 25-15, a resolution authorizing the Executive

Director to add an additional 5-point preference to the Troy Housing Authority Administrative

Plan 4-III.C. Selection Method Chapter for families that currently hold an Emergency Housing

Voucher (EHV), so that THA can transition the EHV voucher to a tenant based voucher to

ensure that the family does not lose their subsidy when the Emergency Housing Program funding
terminates. Commissioner Mason moved to approve the resolution. Commissioner Jackson
seconded the motion. When put to a vote, the resolution passed unanimously.

Chair Sanders moved to Resolution 25-16, a resolution authorizing the Board Chair to execute an employment contract with the selected candidate for the position of Deputy Executive Director as vetted and approved by the Board of Commissioners Finance and Personnel Committee. Upon discussion regarding the material content contained in the contract document, Commissioner McAvoy moved to approve the resolution. Commissioner Rodriguez seconded the motion. When put to a vote, the resolution passed unanimously.

Chair Sanders moved to old and new business. Chair Sanders discussed the 2026 Agency Plan. Executive Director Witkowski then presented her Executive Directors Report.

Chair Sanders then asked for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Mason approved the motion. Commissioner Howard seconded the motion. When put to a vote, the motion was unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 PM.
